

Frequently asked Questions

WILL LEAVES OR PINE NEEDLES GET CAUGHT IN THE BRISTLES?

Sometimes... But don't panic! Debris may be temporarily caught in the top of the brush bristles, but with natural cycles of rain, sun and wind, combined with the high level of airflow through the GutterBrush, most debris either dries out and blows away or self-composts, breaking down into small particles that easily wash down the gutter. Water will continue to flow through the brush and your gutters **WILL NOT CLOG!**

WILL CLEANING OR MAINTENANCE BE REQUIRED?

Your gutters will remain clear and flowing after the installation of GutterBrush. If you ever do need to address gutter debris or a trouble spot, cleaning your gutters becomes as easy as removing sections of the GutterBrush and giving them a quick shake.

IS GUTTERBRUSH VISIBLE FROM THE GROUND?

In lower level gutters you may just see the tips of the GutterBrush bristles. In gutters above 10 – 12 feet, GutterBrush will not be visible.

WILL GUTTERBRUSH HAVE ANY IMPACT ON THE PROBLEM OF ICE DAMS?

Ice Dams are typically the result of improper insulation resulting in a "warm roof." Snow melts on the roof and water trickles down to the gutter area where it freezes again and builds up as a block of ice. GutterBrush will have no effect on this process, but when the sun comes out, the black GutterBrush bristles absorb heat and have been reported to promote rapid melting of any ice build up.

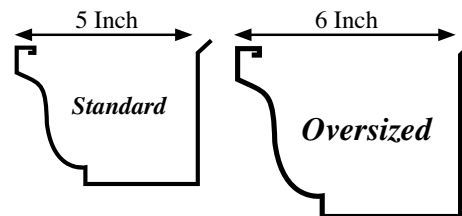

Why Gutter Protection

Clogged gutters are responsible for costly damage to homes.

Rotting fascia boards, Water damage to interior walls and ceilings, surface erosion around the home, wet basements, cracked foundations.

Typical Gutter Protection Solutions:

Screens:



- Frequently Clog & Collapse
- Difficult to Maintain and Clean
- Allow water and ice build up under shingles
- Dirt & rust runoff stains home exterior

Covers:



- Reduce size of gutter opening, allowing water to overflow
- No access to gutters makes maintenance impossible without removal of system
- Interfere with roof / shingles = Roof warranty problems
- Haven for bees nests
- Expensive! Professional installation can cost \$20-\$30 / ft.

The GutterBrush is a simple "Twisted In Wire" brush, similar to a large heavy-duty bottlebrush. Constructed from a galvanized steel core and double UV protected, durable polypropylene bristles.

Available for standard 5 inch and oversized 6 inch gutters

After cleaning your gutters, GutterBrush is installed by simply sliding sections of brush end to end, through your gutters. **No tools are required.**



All gutter protection systems allow some debris to enter gutters and may require limited maintenance. This is why so many professional contractors and do-it-yourselfers prefer a system that is easy to install, remove and clean if needed.
